For foals of 2007. To be raced as three-year-old trotting colts and/or fillies in 2010 who are non-winners of \$75,000 (fillies \$100,000) lifetime as of November 1, 2009, who are OSS eligible and paid.

Eliminations — **Saturday, July 24, 2010** ~ \$12,500 Added

FINAL — **Saturday, July 31, 2010** ~ \$100,000 Guaranteed (\$50,000 Added)

Schedule of Payments

Nomination Fee: \$ 200 due February 15, 2010 (added to final)
Sustaining Fee: \$ 200 due April 15, 2010 (added to final)
Starting Fee: \$ 400 due at time of declaration to start in elimination races (added to eliminations)
Supplemental Entry Fee:..... \$7,500 due prior to the closing of the box for the eliminations.

Conditions

1. All races are to be raced at a distance of one mile.
2. Fillies and colts will be raced together in the eliminations and final
3. The rules of the Ontario Racing Commission at the time shall govern this event.
4. A maximum of eight (8) horses will start in each elimination and the final. In the event that there are nine (9) or fewer declared starters for this event, it shall be conducted as one race only. In such case, all nomination, sustaining, and starting fees will be added to the purse for the one final event.
5. All horses must be declared to start in the eliminations by the regular box closing date and time. Final post positions will be drawn after elim.
6. The top eight (8) finishers in the eliminations will be eligible to be declared to start in the final. Should one or more of the top 8 finishers not declare for the final, then the next top finisher in order will be eligible to enter for the final. Post positions for the final will be drawn in front of the grandstand, shortly after the final elimination on July 24th.
7. All ties will be broken by a draw by lot. There will be a first and second also eligible and they will also be drawn after elims.
8. There must be five (5) or more starters declared to start or the race will be declared off and all money returned as paid.
9. Purse distribution will be on a 50, 25, 12, 8 and 5 percent basis.
10. If there are at least 3 eliminations there will be a 12,000 dollar consolation final, open to all participants, and preference will be given to finish order in the eliminations, but you must enter by the regular box closing time.
